



Projects in Tanzania

In principle, the one-world group Schlins / Röns pursues the goal with their projects - with sustainable education projects, the course for future generations. In a poverty region, a contribution should be made to raising the quality of life of the poorest population. Help for self-help is at the center of our work. In the villages, it has already been achieved that neighborhood assistance, solidarity and compassion for the poorest are formed and developed further on.

Basically with the establishment of an NGO, the goal was defined that the population should be identified with the projects and feel responsible for the further development. The NGO (RDO Rural Development Organization) has now been recognized and confirmed by the Tanzanian state. Our RDO Center in Mdabulo, which is still partially under construction, is a training and meeting place, and is the headquarters with a central office for the organization and coordination of the individual projects

All projects are based on the same system of municipal volunteer committees. The Tanzanian NGO, which we founded, also employs local teachers and co-workers, who, in addition to donations and sponsorship from Vorarlberg / Austria, are also paid for agricultural and artisanal income from the NGO's own farms.

Water projects in the Mufindi- and Kilolo District

At present, our main focus is on the construction of water supply lines in the villages of the region. The population is provided with clean water from professional sources. The water projects were examined by the state (perfect water quality). The construction of water pipes is conducted by Austrian experts and implemented with the help of the population of the individual villages.
